SEWER MAINTENANCE WORKER

Definition:

To perform a variety of skilled work in the maintenance of utilities, facilities and other areas and to do other work as required by the supervisor. This is the entry level in the Sewer Maintenance Worker Series.

Duties (including but not limited to):

- Participate in a seven (7) day weekly standby rotation, including weekends and holidays.
- Maintain and repair sewer system.
- Operate heavy equipment.
- Maintain tools and equipment in working order.
- Assist others during the performance of their work.
- Maintain logs of daily activities.
- Maintain vehicle log.

Knowledge of:

Common tools and materials used in assigned area of responsibility. Basic repair and maintenance of sewer system. Safe working practices and policies.

Ability to:

- On a continuous basis, know and understand maintenance activities and observe safety rules.
- Intermittently analyze problem equipment, identify safety hazards, locate equipment, intercept work orders and operate equipment.
- Intermittently sit while driving a piece of equipment, stand and walk while performing maintenance activities, bend and twist to adjust equipment, kneel and squat to review work, climb up onto heavy equipment to begin operation, perform single and power grasping, pushing, pulling, fine manipulation, lift or carry weights of 50 pounds or less.
- Perform minor maintenance activities related to area of assignment.
- Understand and follow oral and written instruction.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.
- Work with a variety of tools related to public service maintenance.
- Learn to operate a variety of maintenance equipment.
- Perform heavy manual labor.

Experience:

One year experience in the construction and maintenance of a sewer system (PREFERRED)

Training:

Equivalent to completion of the twelfth (12th) grade.

License and Certificate:

- Must currently possess or obtain (within one (1) year) a valid California Class “A” Driver’s License applicable to equipment being operated, including a tank endorsement.
- Must secure a Class “I” State Wastewater License Grade I or higher within two (2) years of hire date.
