- C. A Prop 218 petition was filed in an attempt to invalidate sewer fees that had been recently adopted by the district. However, the petitioner was ruled against by the trial court judge, resulting in the lawsuit being unsuccessful. The petitioner then filed a notice of appeal but withdrew it in exchange for a waiver of costs, including copying and transcript preparation costs. As a result, the district successfully resolved the Prop 218 petition and there is now a written settlement agreement in place regarding the dismissal of the lawsuit by the petitioner.
- D. Mr. Mansfield did not defend the case, therefore he lost by default. As a result, the default judgment is currently being processed.
- E. Previously, the district provided notice to Mr. Prager that his claim was untimely, so no action was taken.
